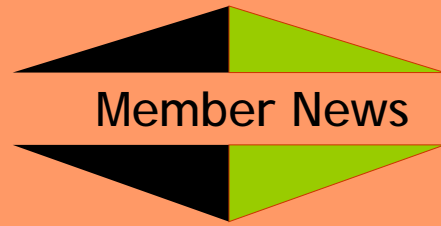
She is a part of the 2000-2001 Leadership Columbus Class.

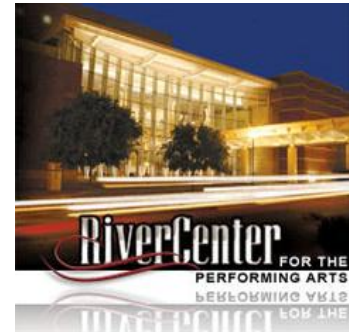
